

ITP Library

ITP's commitment to quality academic instruction and excellence in research is reflected by the variety of resources available in the Library. The library, established in 1976, is the research center for residential and global students at the Institute. It contains approximately 15,000 books, 1000 audio tapes and CDs, 700 videos and DVDs, 170 journal titles, 240 ITP dissertations, and 70 master's theses, in addition to electronic resources. The strength of the collection is in the six major areas of the Institute's curriculum: transpersonal theory and research, spiritual psychology, emotional and clinical psychology, bodywork disciplines, expressive arts, and the social aspects of the transpersonal. Computers for student use, access to online research databases, and the ability to obtain additional research materials from other libraries are also available.

To Begin:

Go to the ITP Library Web site: <http://www.itp.edu/library>

Mouse over the Find in Databases menu and select Access Online Databases

Select a Database Collection or Specialized Database:

Some databases are grouped under a vendor, such as CSA, ProQuest, or EBSCO.

There are also individual databases, such as JTP, ebrary, etc.

Enter User Name and Password. (Contact Library if you need this information)

Use these databases to search for information on your topic. Look for full text links.

Use the A to Z List of Full Text Journal Titles:

The A to Z List of Full Text Journal Titles lists journals that have full text available at ITP.

Use this to find out if a journal title has full text access at ITP.

This provides journal titles and not subject access to articles.
